The New Haven Department's Immunization Action Plan program (IAP) works with physician offices to ensure that all area children are being immunized according to schedule. The IAP coordinator and outreach staff work to perform the following objectives:

- Conduct outreach and track results using the statewide immunization information system (IIS) known as “CT WiZ”.
- Educate the public about the importance of vaccinations.
- Conduct assessments in pediatric practices to improve vaccine delivery and storage.
- Raise the immunization rates in New Haven.
- Link children without a medical home to a medical home so their immunizations may be up-to-date.
