NEW HAVEN, Conn. – On Wednesday, February 10, at 10:30 AM, Mayor Justin Elicker will join U.S. Rep. Rosa DeLauro, Board of Alders President Tyisha Walker-Myers, City Health Director Maritza Bond, and local clergy leaders to visit a pop-up COVID-19 vaccination clinic for the residents of the Berger Apartments, an elderly and disabled housing community at 135 Derby Ave. in New Haven.

The City is taking vaccination appointments for those 65 years of age and older.
